- Obtain two letters of recommendation from a teacher, school counselor, coach, etc.
- Provide evidence of Community Service
- Write an essay (500 words or less) on the topic of “How has your community service helped shape who you are and/or your plans for the future?”.
- Complete, sign, and email application along with all required attachments **NO LATER THAN Friday March 31, 2023.** Please use subject line “POCT Scholarship Application” and send to info@pctrust.org.

ONLY COMPLETED APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED BY THE COMMITTEE AND MAKE SURE TO RESPOND WITH DETAILED ANSWERS TO ALL QUESTIONS.

All applicants will be considered and a decision will be made by our scholarship committee. It is possible an interview will occur to help determine scholarship recipients.
